2. About the College

Nestled in a sylvan background of a tea estate, Rabindranath Thakur Mahavidyalaya, Bishalgarh caters to the need of higher education to the rural youths comprising of minority ethnic groups and marginalized sections of society in Sepahijala District in Tripura. The College was established in 15th June, 2012 at a sprawling campus of 9.34 acres in a tranquil natural setting at Harishnagar village. The College is affiliated to Tripura University and recognised by UGC under section 2(f)& 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956 and recently accredited Grade 'B' by NAAC. The College offers Honours programme in six Humanities subjects and one in Biological Science along with general courses in Humanities and Biological Science. The College, with its dedicated faculty members and available resources, strives to inculcate the desire for lifelong learning among the students to be the change makers for the development of our nation.

This prospectus 2023 provides necessary admission related information, the courses offered by the College along with corresponding eligibility guidelines and fee structure.

6. Eligibility Criteria for Admission

Eligibility for Admission to the College as per regulations governing UG Programme in accordance with NEP 2020 notified by Tripura University-

(i) Any student passing Higher Secondary/ H.S. (+2)/ Senior Secondary examination or its equivalent from any recognized Board/ Council shall be eligible for admission to the 1st Semester of the Under Graduate (B.A./B.Sc.) programme of studies subject to availability of seats.

The student shall be taken into account for admission if he /she applied within five years from the year of passing (e.g., within 2018-2022 from YoP 2023) in the previous qualifying Examination. The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination.

- For B.Sc.(Biological Science), a candidate who has passed ii. (10+2) stage with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology shall be eligible for Admission.
- For B.A. Programme, a candidate who has passed 10+2 in any stream shall be eligible to take admission.

Admission Restriction:

If a candidate takes admission in any college, he/she cannot take admission in any other college. In case of admission in a second college, the admission in first college must be surrendered.

7. Marks Structure of Papers:

A. For courses of 100 marks without practical component:

Internal Assessment* : 40 marks
Theory : 60 marks

B. For courses of 100 marks with practical component: Internal Assessment* (Theory: 24 + Practical: 16): 40 marks

Theory + Practical (36 + 24) : 60 marks

*(Internal Assessment marks includes attendance marks)

8. Attendance:

As per regulations of Tripura University,

- 1. A student having attendance below 65% (65% Theoretical and 65% Practical classes) of the classes held in any Semester shall be declared as Dis-Collegiate and he / she shall not be allowed to appear at the Semester-I/ Semester-II/ Semester-II/ Semester-V/ Semester-V/ and Semester-VI/ Semester-VIII Examinations and shall have to be readmitted.
- 2. A student may also be allowed to sit for any Semester Examination as a Non-Collegiate candidate, if he / she has attended minimum 65% of classes held in Theory and Practical separately in each Semester.
- 3. A student shall be deemed to have pursued a regular course of study (in a subject) during each semester, and he / she has attended at least 75% classes. 5% marks is to be credited for attendance. 5% marks for attendance shall be distributed as follows:

a) (75% to <80%) attendance 1 mark b) (80% to <85%) attendance 2 marks

c) (85% to <90%) attendance 3 marks

d) (90% to <95%) attendance 4 marks e) (95% and above) attendance 5 marks

9. Change of Subjects:

An option to change a subject may be exercised only once within 4 weeks from the date of commencement of I/III semester on payment of prescribed fee of Tripura University.

10. Result:

A student shall be declared as passed in a Course (Paper) in a semester examination, provided he / she secures at least 40% marks separately in Internal Assessment and End Term Examination.

Further provided that in case of Course (Paper) having practical component a student shall have to secure 40% marks separately in Theory and Practical component.
